DISPOSITION: DOCKET CLOSED

At its September 12, 2000, regular public meeting, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) approved a recommendation by its Staff to close this docket. The Staff recommendation is attached to this order as an Appendix and is incorporated by reference herein.

This investigation was initiated in early 1999 after the Commission became aware of problems with the quality and availability of service provided by U S WEST Communications, Inc. (USWC), now Qwest Corporation (Qwest). In response to those concerns, the Commission conducted a number of public meetings in communities throughout Oregon. As a result of those meetings and the investigation of various service complaints, Staff determined that service problems were caused in part by the deferral or cancellation of construction projects which had been included in USWC's construction budgets.

In view of the change in management at Qwest and the general service quality trend, there appears to be no compelling reason to continue this docket. At the same time, it is important for the Commission to be able to continue monitoring Qwest's construction activities. We therefore adopt Staff's recommendation that Qwest's annual construction budget filing include a list of deviations from the previous year's construction budget.
