DISPOSITION: PETITION DISMISSED

On November 5, 1998, Columbia River People's Utility District (CRPUD) filed a petition for a declaratory ruling pursuant to ORS 756.450. CRPUD asked the Commission to declare that CRPUD has an exclusive territorial allocation because of previous Commission orders. However, if the Commission determined that CRPUD does not have a currently valid territorial allocation, CRPUD asked the Commission to allocate a territory to CRPUD in this proceeding.

On January 4, 1999, CRPUD requested that this proceeding be held in abeyance with no further processing until CRPUD requested the proceeding commence again. On September 26, 2000, Administrative Law Judge Lowell Bergen issued a Memorandum to the parties stating that the proceeding would have to move forward or be dismissed. He stated that he would prepare an order dismissing the petition if no response was filed by October 13, 2000.

No response to the memorandum has been filed. The parties have obviously decided to discontinue consideration of this matter. The petition should be dismissed and the docket closed.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the petition of Columbia River People's Utility District for a Declaratory Ruling is dismissed, and the docket is closed.
