SECOND SUSPENSION ORDER

DISPOSITION: PETITION SUSPENDED

On May 15, 2000, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) filed a petition to exempt from regulation Frame Relay Services (FRS), Asynchronous Transfer Mode (ATM), Call Relay Service (Carriers), and Local Area Network Switching Service (LSS).

Commission Staff reviewed the application and recommended that the Commission suspend and further investigate Qwest's petition. On July 10, 2000, at its Regular Public Meeting, the Commission voted to adopt Staff's recommendation and suspended the petition. The suspension period runs until December 15, 2000.

On November 22, 2000, Qwest filed a letter with the Commission asking that the suspension period be extended for an additional three months, until March 15, 2001. Qwest is in the process of obtaining information that will support its petition. Many of the participants in the docket have agreed to answer the questionnaires propounded by Qwest by December 13, 2000, and Commission Staff has agreed to aggregate that information. Further, the Commission has scheduled a prehearing conference for January 18, 2001. Because the discovery process will not be completed by December 15, Qwest argues that good cause exists for such an extension.

The Commission finds that the investigation into this matter will not be completed at the expiration of the initial suspension. Pursuant to ORS 759.030(7), the Commission orders a further suspension of Qwest's petition to exempt from regulation FRS, ATM, Carriers, and LSS. The tariff is suspended until March 15, 2001.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the petition by Qwest to exempt from regulation Frame Relay Services, Asynchronous Transfer Mode, Call Relay Service, and Local Area Network Switching Service is suspended until March 15, 2001.
