ORDER

DISPOSITION: STIPULATION ADOPTED

On December 15, 2000, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a complaint against Defendant. The complaint charged Defendant with one violation of law and requested a penalty of \$1,000. On January 5, 2001, a copy of the complaint was served.

On January 9, 2001, the parties to this proceeding entered into a stipulation, which is attached and incorporated by reference.

Defendant admits committing the violation alleged in the complaint. The stipulation is adopted.

From the foregoing, it is concluded that no hearing is required. Under the terms of the stipulation, the allegations of the complaint are true, and Defendant has violated Oregon Administrative Rule(s) as alleged. Pursuant to the provisions of ORS 757.993, penalties should be assessed against Defendant under the terms and conditions of the stipulation.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Civil monetary penalties shall be assessed against Defendant in the amount of \$1,000; and
2. Defendant shall pay the sum of \$200, due and payable within 30 days from the date of service of this order; and
3. Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$800) shall be suspended for a period of one year following entry of this order; and
4. Within 45 days following entry of this Order, Defendant shall arrange for a training session on Oregon excavation laws by contacting the Oregon Utility Notification Center (OUNC) Speakers Bureau.
5. Complainant may reopen this proceeding and petition for imposition of all or a portion of the suspended penalties if Defendant has not complied with all OUNC rules for a period of one year following entry of this order.

STIPULATION FOR ENTRY OF FINAL ORDER

12 The Public Utility Commission of Oregon, appearing by and through Paul A. Graham,
13 Assistant Attorney General, and WRG Design, Inc., the defendant herein, hereby stipulate as
14 follows:

15 1.

16 A Complaint in this case is pending before the Commission charging the defendant with
17 one violation of law, as set out in the attached Complaint on file herein.

18 2.

19 Both parties to this proceeding are willing to forego further processing of that Complaint
20 and further are willing to resolve this matter on the basis of this stipulation.

21 3.

22 The defendant admits that the violation was committed as alleged in the Complaint and is
23 willing for the Commission to enter an order finding that the violation was committed as alleged
24 in the Complaint.

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4 The parties further agree that the Commission may enter an order assessing civil
5 monetary penalties against the defendant in the amount of \$1000 under the following terms and
6 conditions:

7 A. \$200 shall become due and payable on or before the 30th day following the
8 Commission's entry of a final order in this case. Payment shall be by cashier's check or
9 money order made out to the Public Utility Commission of Oregon, and the memo line of
10 the cashier's check or money order shall state the "NC" docket number in the caption of
11 this stipulation. Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$800) shall be suspended for a
12 period of one year following the entry of the Commission's final order in this case. If
13 defendant complies with all of the rules adopted by the Oregon Utility Notification
14 Center (OUNC) under ORS 757.552 for that one year period, the suspended penalties
15 (\$800) shall be dismissed and no further penalties shall be imposed for the violation
16 alleged in the Complaint.

17 B. Within 45 days following entry of the Commission's final order, defendant shall
18 arrange for a training session on Oregon excavation laws by contacting the OUNC
19 Speakers Bureau.

20 C. In the event that complainant contends that the defendant has not complied with
21 all OUNC rules for that one year period, complainant may reopen this proceeding and
22 petition for imposition of all or a portion of the suspended penalties. In such case
23 defendant shall be entitled to a hearing and to be notified of the basis upon which
24 complainant contends that compliance has not occurred.

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This stipulation is conditioned upon final approval of its terms by the Commission. If the stipulation is not accepted in its entirety, it shall be deemed withdrawn.
