DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On May 16, 2000, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Onsite Access Local, LLC (Onsite) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 00-260. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. In July and October 2000, Commission Staff requested information from Onsite. The Commission did not receive the requested information, so on January 2, 2001, Onsite's certificate of authority was cancelled in Order No. 01-055.

On January 16, 2001, Onsite filed a motion and affidavit contesting the cancellation of its certificate. A copy of the requested information was attached to the motion. The affidavit states that the requested information was faxed to the Commission on November 10, 2000.

The information sent by fax may have been lost in transmission. A facsimile copy of a document can be used to file information with the Commission, but the Commission also requires the filing of the original document.

The requested information now has been received from Onsite. The cancellation of Onsite's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 01-055 canceling the certificate of authority of Onsite Access Local, LLC is rescinded.
