DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On April 14, 1997, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Claircom Networks Inc. (CNI) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 97-136. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. In July and October, 2000, Commission Staff requested information from CNI. The Commission's records indicated that the agency did not receive the requested information, so on January 2, 2001, CNI's certificate of authority was cancelled in Order No. 01-061.

On February 1, 2001, CNI filed a request to suspend Order No. 01-061, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. In consulting with Mr. Tom Turner of the Commission staff on January 31, 2001, CNI discovered it had transmitted its information to Mr. Turner's telephone number, rather than his facsimile number. The requested information now has been received from CNI.

A facsimile copy of a document can be used to file information with the Commission, but the Commission also requires the filing of the original document.

The information sent by CNI to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates CNI is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of CNI's certificate should be rescinded.
