DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On September 16, 1997, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to ConnectAmerica Inc. (ConnectAmerica) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 97-362. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. In July and October 2000, Commission Staff requested information from ConnectAmerica. The Commission's records indicated that the agency did not receive the requested information, so on January 2, 2001, ConnectAmerica's certificate of authority was cancelled in Order No. 01-063.

On February 2, 2001, ConnectAmerica filed a request to suspend Order No. 01-063, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that ConnectAmerica filed the requested information on December 19, 2000.

The information has been received and it indicates ConnectAmerica is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of ConnectAmerica's certificate should be rescinded.
