DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On December 1, 1997, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to United Services Telephone LLC (USTL) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 97-457. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. In July and October 2000, Commission Staff requested information from USTL. The Commission's records indicated that the agency did not receive the requested information, so on January 2, 2001, USTL's certificate of authority was cancelled in Order No. 01-028.

On January 30, 2001, USTL filed a request to suspend Order No. 01-028, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that USTL filed the requested information on December 15, 2000.

The information sent by USTL to the Commission had no company name on it, so it was noted as not having been filed. However, the information has been received and it indicates USTL is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of USTL's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 01-028 canceling the certificate of authority of United Services Telephone LLC, is rescinded.
