DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On May 31, 2000, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Adelphia Business Solutions Operations, Inc. (Adelphia) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No 00-285. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. In July and October, 2000, Commission Staff requested information from Adelphia. The Commission's records indicated that the agency did not receive the requested information, so on January 2, 2001, Adelphia's certificate of authority was cancelled in Order No. 01-003.

On February 13, 2001, Adelphia filed a request to suspend Order No. 01-003, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations, attaching a copy of the requested information. Adelphia included the requested information to the Commission on February 13, 2001.

The OUS information was apparently sent to the Commission by Adelphia to the incorrect address. In addition, Adelphia's facsimile to the Commission regarding the PUC fee information was lost. However, the information now has been received and it indicates Adelphia is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Adelphia's certificate should be rescinded.
