ORDER

**DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED**

On March 15, 1999, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Maxxis Communications, Inc. (Maxxis) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 99-212. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. In July and October, 2000, Commission Staff requested information from Maxxis. The Commission's records indicated that the agency did not receive the requested information, so on January 2, 2001, Maxxis' certificate of authority was cancelled in Order No. 01-015.

On March 16, 2001, Maxxis filed a request to suspend Order No. 01-015, stating that it had not complied with the Commission's rules and regulations due to an oversight, and that it has currently complied. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Maxxis filed the requested information on March 16, 2001.

The information sent by Maxxis to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Maxxis is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Maxxis' certificate should be rescinded.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 01-015 canceling the certificate of authority of Maxxis Communications Inc., is rescinded.
