**DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED**

On November 17, 2000, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Metropolitan Telecommunications of Oregon Inc. (Metropolitan) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 00-746. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. In January and March, 2001, Commission Staff requested information from Metropolitan. The Commission's records indicated that the agency did not receive the requested information. At the April 17, 2001 public meeting, the Commission determined that Metropolitan's certificate of authority should be cancelled. Metropolitan's certificate of authority was cancelled in Order No. 01-362.

On May 16, 2001, Metropolitan filed a request to suspend Order No. 01-362, stating that it had failed to respond to the Commission's requests, but has now complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Metropolitan filed the requested information on May 10, 2001.

The information sent by Metropolitan to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Metropolitan is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Metropolitan's certificate should be rescinded.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 01-362 canceling the certificate of authority of Metropolitan Telecommunications of Oregon Inc., is rescinded.
