**DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED**

On September 4, 1998, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to ACI Corp. to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 98-367. The company later changed its name to Rhythms Links Inc. (RLI). Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. On August 10, 2001, RLI filed a letter stating that it is discontinuing telecommunications service. On August 22, 2001, RLI's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 01-746.

On September 10, 2001, RLI filed a request to rescind Order No. 01-746. RLI informed the Commission that although its August 10 letter stated that it was discontinuing service to its customers in Oregon, the letter was only providing an update to the Commission of its current activities, not requesting that its certificate of authority be canceled.

Under the circumstances, the cancellation of RLI's certificate should be rescinded.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 01-746 canceling the certificate of authority of Rhythms Links Inc., is rescinded.
