DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On July 15, 2002, TransWorld Network Corp. (TWN) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 02-457.


In a letter dated February 8, 2008, Colin Wood, CEO of TWN, requested that their certificate of authority be cancelled. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon for more than one day in 2008, it is required to file an annual fee statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by TransWorld Network Corp. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by TransWorld Network Corp. is cancelled.
