DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On April 2, 2007, Universal Telecom Inc. ("Universal") was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 07-117.

In a letter received on April 23, 2008, Stephen Roderick, Chief Executive Officer of Universal Telecom Inc., informed the Commission that Universal is no longer in business and its certificate of authority should be withdrawn. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2008, it is required to file a revenue fee statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Universal Telecom Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Universal Telecom Inc. is cancelled.
