**DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED**

On February 2, 2007, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Bigredwire.com Inc. (Bigredwire) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 07-042. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Bigredwire failed to file an annual report for the year 2007 as required by OAR 860-032-0060(2)(a). On June 10, 2008, the Commission notified Bigredwire that the report had not been received. At the July 29, 2008, public meeting, the Commission determined that Bigredwire's certificate of authority should be canceled. Bigredwire's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 08-401.


On September 22, 2008, Bigredwire filed a request to suspend Order No. 08-401, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Bigredwire filed the requested information.

The information sent by Bigredwire to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Bigredwire is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Bigredwire's certificate should be rescinded.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 08-401 canceling the certificate of authority of Bigredwire.com Inc., is rescinded.
