ERRATA ORDER

DISPOSITION: ORDER NO. 16-093 CORRECTED

We issue this order to correct what we conclude to be a typographical error contained in a stipulation we adopted in and attached to Order No. 16-093. The error relates to the amount of Oregon Universal Service Funds (OUSF) to be paid to Qwest Corporation, dba CenturyLink QC.

On June 18, 2015, the parties submitted a joint motion to adopt stipulation. At page 5 of the motion, the parties included a table which, among other things, noted that in the year 2020 Qwest Corporation would receive \$8,190,000 from the Oregon Universal Service Fund out of a total of \$13,650,000 allocated to non-rural carriers for that year.

After we denied that stipulation in Order No. 15-365, the parties filed a revised stipulation on January 29, 2016. We adopted the new stipulation in Order No. 16-093, which included the stipulation as Appendix A. That stipulation included a table similar to the table on page 5 of the parties' June 18, 2015 motion, except that the 2020 Qwest Corporation amount was listed as \$9,190,000, notwithstanding the fact that the amount allocated to the other non-rural carrier as well as the \$13,650,000 total, were unchanged. We conclude that this arithmetic discrepancy was due to a typographical error.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the table on Appendix A page 2 to Order No. 16-093 is amended by deleting the entry \$9,190,000 at the intersection of Qwest Corporation and 2020 and replacing it with \$8,190,000.
